### At the 15 closed caves we placed informative boards

At the 15 closed caves we placed informative boards. These panels contain information about the closed cave, from which natural protected area is part of, the reason why it was closed: bats species found in the cave and general information about bats, the appropriate mode of behavior in the cave, contact of the protected area administrator, visitation arrangements, general information on the project within the panel was made, the beneficiaries, co-financed by the Life Programme of the European Union, Salvaspeo information in case of accident. The panels are made in three languages: Romanian, English and Hungarian. They are designed to inform, train and educate the general public which can reach in front of one of the 15 closed caves on the common sense that we should have to the natural values and natural capital we hold: caves and bats.

This activity is part of the project “**Bat conservation in Pădurea Craiului, Bihor and Trascău Mountains**”, LIFE+ Nature and Biodiversity, co-financed by the Life Programme of the European Union and implemented by the Environment Protection Agency of Bihor County, the Romanian Bat Protection Association and the “Emil Racoviță” Institute of Speleology in Cluj aims at the conservation of the protected species living on the territory of the project. The budget of the project is 1.286.575 euros.

The main aim of the project is the long-term conservation of the bat species living on the 19 NATURA 2000 Sites by a well developed management plan of the targeted bat species, and by informing the public about the importance of bats, their ecological need and the importance of their protection.
